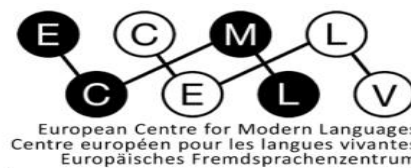


European Day of Languages

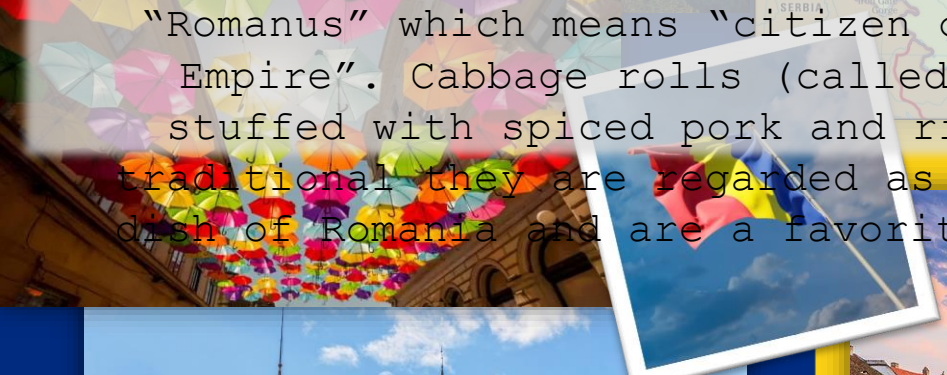
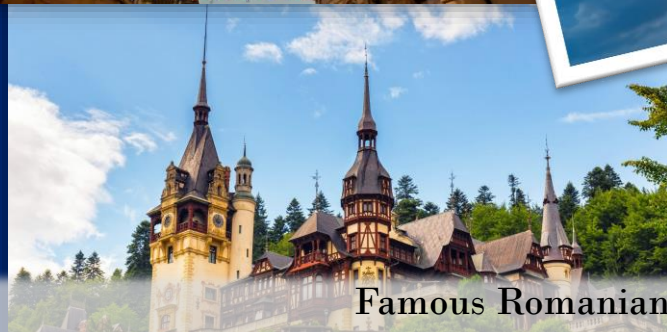
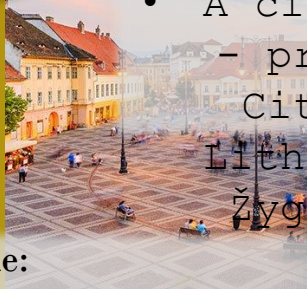

Famous Romanian people:

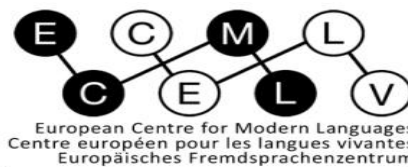
1. Simona Halep - professional tennis player, No. 1 in singles twice between 2017 and 2019.

4. Nadia Comaneci - gymnast, winner of five Olympic gold medals.

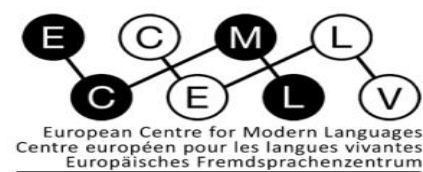

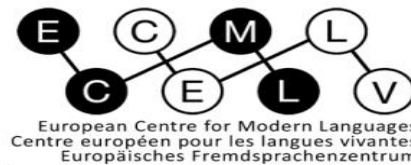

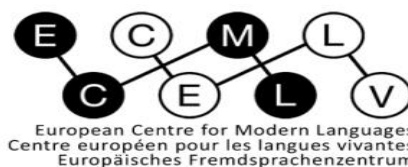

Skadar Lake is the largest lake in the Balkans.

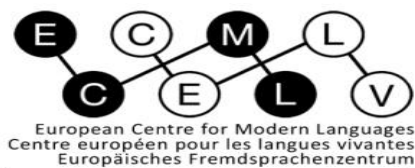
Montenegro is home to the unique phoenix plant: the delicate Ramonda Serbica, a legally protected flowering plant that grows on the slopes of Rumija, and when it dries it can come back to life with the first rains.

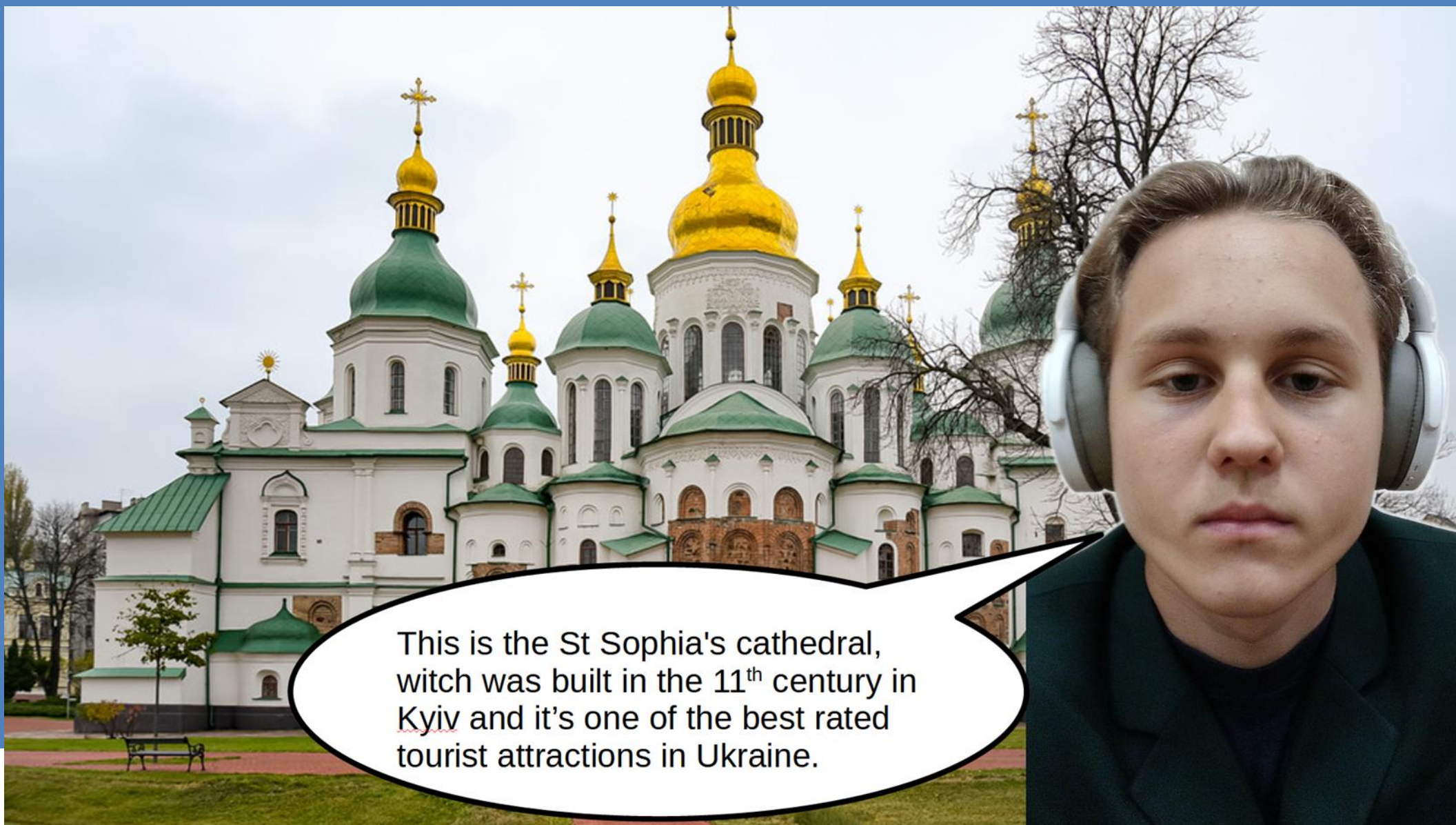




This is the St Sophia's cathedral,
